FINAL RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INSTALLATION OF SIGNS AND LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS AGAINST BENEFITED PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF MILTON, ROCK COUNTY, WISCONSIN

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Milton, Wisconsin, held a public hearing at the Town Hall at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, May 14, 2018, for the purpose of hearing all interested persons concerning the preliminary resolution and report of the Town Clerk on the proposed two-sided 911 address signs and preliminary assessments against benefitted property, and heard all persons who desired to speak at the hearing;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town Board determines as follows:

- 1. The report of the Town Clerk, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if fully set forth herein, including the plans and specifications and assessments set forth therein, is adopted and approved.
- 2. The Town Clerk shall supervise installation of the signs in accordance with the report hereby adopted.
- 3. Payment for the signs shall be made by assessing the entire cost to the property benefitted as indicated in the report.
- 4. Assessments shown on the report represent an exercise of the police power and have been determined on a reasonable basis and are hereby confirmed.
- 5. Assessments shall be placed on the next tax roll. All assessments that are not paid by the date on which payment under the next tax roll is due shall be delinquent.
- 6. The Town Clerk shall publish this resolution as a class 1 notice under Chapter 985 of the Wisconsin Statutes and mail a copy of this resolution and a statement of the final assessment against the benefitted property to every property owner whose name appears on the assessment roll whose post office address is known or can with reasonable diligence be ascertained.
