Dog Licenses

Pursuant to Chapter 174.05(2) of WI Statues, <u>all dogs</u>, more than 5 months of age, shall annually obtain a dog license and are required to have Rabies Vaccinations. Licenses may be obtained at the Town Hall during normal business hours. If you are unable to do this during Office hours, you may <u>mail a copy of the current rabies vaccination</u>, <u>self-addressed stamped envelope along with the proper fee to the Town Hall Office</u>, forms available on Town's website, and the Clerk will mail the license tag to you.

License Fees

Spayed/Neutered- \$8.00 Not Altered- \$15.00 Handicapped and duplicates have no charge. Late fee- \$10.00/per dog for renewing after April 1st.

Town of Milton Dog Ordinance has changed- You are now allowed no more than 4 dogs.

5 or more dogs will require a multiple dog license, subject to approval and review by the Town Board annually.

<u>First Dollar Credit</u> – If your taxable parcel has *real property improvements*, then you qualify for this; property does not have to be primary resident of owner. Personal property improvement does not qualify. Property owner does not have to apply for this credit.

<u>Lottery Credit</u> – If credit does NOT show on your tax statement, you must fill out a card at the County Treasurers' office, at the time of payment to receive your credit, if **you** are eligible. Cards must be filled out completely, including Tax ID number and legal description.

The Rock County website has daily updates to the Rock County Tax Database to allow community members to see if payments have been applied to their tax bills. The directions are shown below:

- 1. Go to http://www.co.rock.wi.us/treasurer
- 2. Click on "Tax Database Search"
- 3. Type in the property address, parcel number (starts with "6-13") or Tax ID number (starts with "026"). If using the street name, it's best to not include words or abbreviations such as Road, Street, West, East, Etc.
- 4. Once you see your address, click on "Current Taxes" and you can then view previous tax bills and payment history by clicking on links at the top of the page.

<u>Conditional Use, Variance, Zoning Applications along with Bartender Licenses and Liquor Licenses:</u> – Applied for with Town Clerk- (Forms are available on Town's Website)

Weed Control & Mowing: State Law requires that property owners destroy all noxious weeds. It is suggested that you also do your road side mowing.

<u>Motor Vehicle Registration:</u> – When registering your vehicles with the DMV, make sure you indicate they are kept in the **TOWN** of Milton, not the City, it affects Town taxes and revenues.

Burning Info: Property owners will be responsible for charges resulting from fires caused by negligence or failure to report a controlled burn. You Must call: Milton Fire Department-868-2842, Town Chairman- Bryan Meyer 774-9229 and Non- emergency 757-2244

<u>Building Permits, Demolition Permits and Inspections:</u> Before digging or erecting any structure on your property, (this includes vinyl or metal covered carports mounted on posts), contact David Geraths, Building Inspector at **608-697-7776**. Penalty for building without a permit will be equal to the permit fee! Fee schedule and permits are available on the Town's website.

<u>Notices and Postings</u>: Published in our official newspaper, Milton Courier. All notices are posted at the Town Hall, First Community Bank and on the Town's website.

Board of Review: Will be held within a 45day time period following the 2nd Monday of May.

<u>Town Board Meetings:</u> Held on 2nd Monday of each month, at the Town Hall, 23 First Street. Immediately following the Planning and Zoning Committee Meeting which starts at 6:30pm, unless otherwise published.
