TOWN OF MILTON ORDINANCE NO. 2022-3

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND RESTATING A PORTION OF THE TOWN OF MILTON MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING MEMBERSHIP ON THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMITTEE.

NOW THEREFORE, THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF MILTON, COUNTY OF ROCK, STATE OF WISCONSIN, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 16 of Chapter 400 of the Town of Milton Code of Ordinances, entitled "Membership" is hereby amended and restated in its entirety to read as follows:

"Membership.

- A. The Town Planning and Zoning Committee shall consist of five members. One member may be a Town Board member. The Town Chairman shall appoint the Committee's presiding officer. The Town Board shall appoint four citizen members who upon creation of the Committee shall be appointed for one, two, and two members for three-year terms. The Town Clerk and Building Inspector shall be ex officio members and shall attend all Planning and Zoning meetings but shall not be voting members.
- B. The Town Chairman may appoint, for staggered three-year terms, two alternate members of the Committee, who are subject to confirmation of the Town Board. Annually, the Town Chairman shall designate one of the alternate members as the first alternate and the other as the second alternate. The first alternate shall act, with full power, only when a member of the Committee refuses to vote because of a conflict of interest or when a member is absent. The second alternate shall act only when the first alternate refuses to vote because of a conflict of interest or is absent, or if more than one member of the Committee refuses to vote because of a conflict of interest or is absent."

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage by the Town Board and posting by the Town Clerk as required by law.
